Objectives	<p>The aims are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Share, exchange and transfer best practices, new methodological approaches and experiences among partner organizations dealing with adult education with a focus on labour market, related service and vocational training programme - Ameliorate and reinforce the capacities and competences of organizations partners' internal staff through the use of English as professional language and e-tools (ITCs services) as daily working instruments - Create cross-border networks among relevant actors working in the sector in each country through the involvement meetings and workshops <p>The participative approach of the action aims at sharing experiences among partners in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Job counseling, orientation and information service (how to boast key competences, to ameliorate job hunting practices) - Analysis national labour market and laws of each represented country with a focus on European regulations and updates on new EU programmes and opportunities - Focus on peer education as strategic innovative educational method
